



Cleaning of room.

- ✓ The whole room should be cleaned in a conventional way, and walls, ceiling and wardrobes washed with mild soap water.
- ✓ Floor should be washed with soap water.
- ✓ The curtains should be washed, along with the window, windowsill, and curtain rail.
- ✓ Bathroom appliances (toilet, shower, and sink), faucets and mirrors should be cleaned with appropriate cleansing agents (rough sponge is best to remove the silica).
- ✓ Take the mattress cover and wash in the washing machine, dry it and put it back on the bed.
- ✓ Make sure all light bulbs are functional.
- ✓ Tenants must share the work of cleaning common areas such as kitchen, living room and laundry room. Leaving the common areas tidy is everyone's responsibility.
- ✓ The freezers should be defrosted and cleaned, refrigerators should be clean and dry.
- ✓ The stove and baking oven should be cleaned inside and out along with all appliances. The hood above the stove should also be cleaned.
- ✓ The microwave should be properly cleaned inside and out.
- ✓ All cutleries, plates and glasses should be left clean in the cupboards.
- ✓ All keys that tenant has received should be returned to the operation manager.
- ✓ Contact the manager (festa@unak.is) to schedule time for inspection of room.
- ✓ If tenants leave without scheduling an inspection, 5000, - ISK will be withdrawn from their deposit.
- ✓ If cleaning is unsatisfactory, FÉSTA will hire professionals to clean, and the expense withdrawn from the tenant's deposit.
- ✓ **ATTN!**
The room/apartment has not been returned until an inspection has been performed, including in communal spaces like kitchen and living rooms.
